



NOTICE TO INDIVIDUALS RECEIVING SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER TREATMENT SERVICES

SEMCA and the Community Mental Health Partnership of Southeast Michigan (CMHPSM) want to provide you with notice that effective OCTOBER 1, 2014, there will be a change in access to services and funding oversight for Monroe County residents who are seeking Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment and recovery services. We hope to make this transition seamless, with little to no disruption of services to those of you who will continue in treatment on October 1st. Your provider will be able to assist you should there be any problems and we would be happy to help answer any questions you might have.

If you are a Medicaid Recipient and have a need to file an appeal for a fair hearing, the CMHPSM will arrange for you to speak to a fair hearings officer or customer service representative. You can call Monroe CMHA (734) 243-7340 and ask to speak with C.J. Witherow, Fair Hearings Officer.

If you need to access additional treatment services, you can contact your provider or the SUD ACCESS representative placed at the Monroe Community Mental Health Authority (734) 243-7340. You can also contact the CMHPSM Treatment Services Coordinator, Anne Marshall, at 734-222-3843 for additional help.
